The **OUTDOOR4MI** project is an innovative ERASMUS+ KA2 project aimed at promoting the implementation of Outdoor Education (OE) in kindergartens, with special attention to children with mobility impairments.



Objectives

To address the existing ecological crisis and decrease the impact of human activities on nature, it is necessary to implement an education that guides children towards acquiring sustainable behaviors and attitudes.

Therefore, Outdoor Education emerges aiming to create an opportunity for children to establish a meaningful connection with the environment.

The OUTDOOR4MI Project aims to:

- Develop sensitivity, respect, and environmental awareness in children aged 3-5 towards nature;
- Provide kindergarten educators with the skills and resources necessary for the implementation of Outdoor Education (OE), both inside and outside the classroom;
- Promote and facilitate the inclusion of children with mobility impairments in OE practice.
